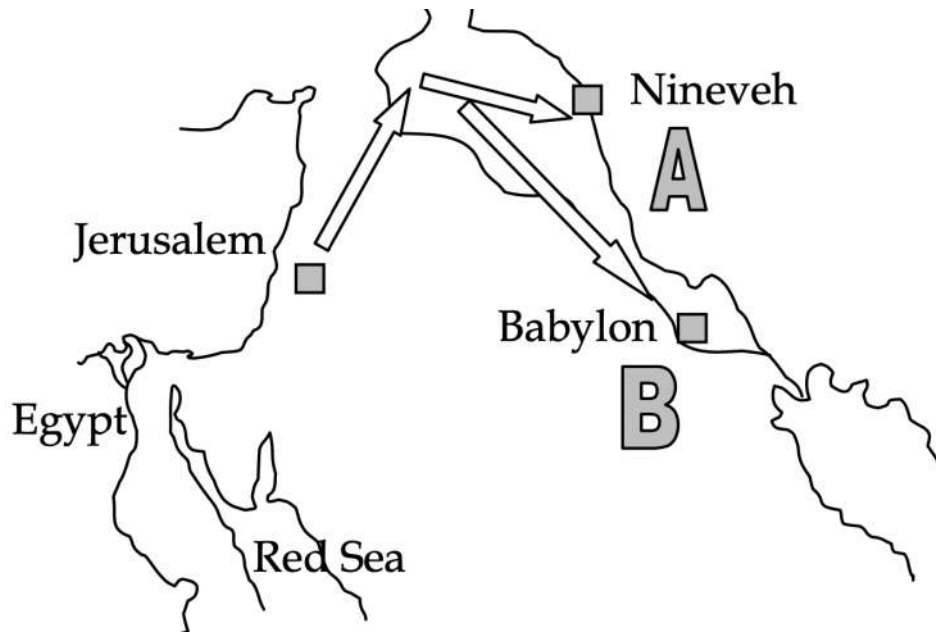

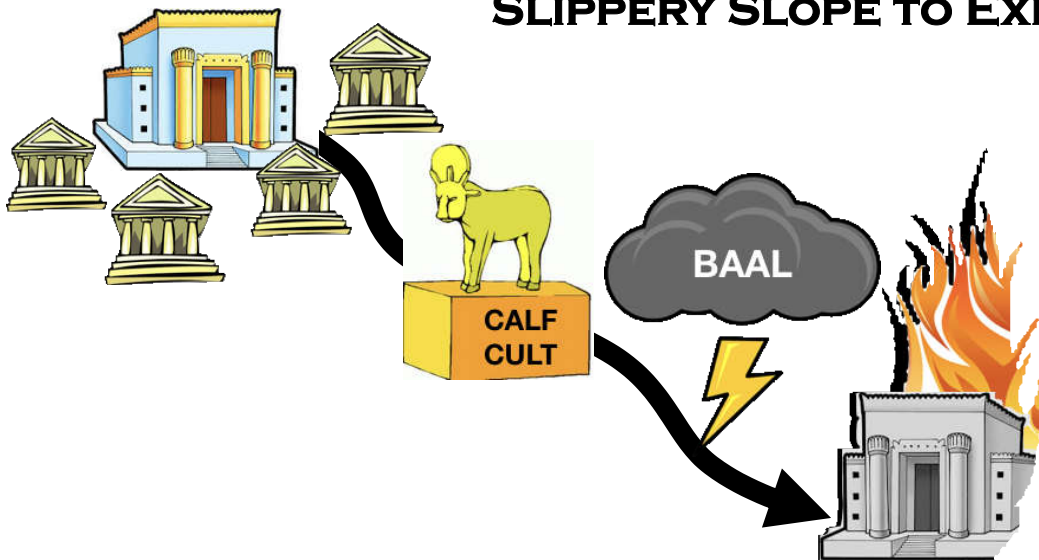

SLIPPERY SLOPE TO EXILE



Exile as divorce

- Isaiah 50:1 - This is what the LORD says: “Where is your mother's **certificate of divorce** with which I sent her away? Or to which of my creditors did I sell you? Because of your sins you were sold; because of your transgressions your mother was sent away.
- Jeremiah 3:8 - I gave faithless Israel her **certificate of divorce** and sent her away because of all her adulteries. Yet I saw that her unfaithful sister Judah had no fear; she also went out and committed adultery.
- Jeremiah 31:31 – The days are coming when I will make a **new covenant** with the people of Israel and the people of Judah.

Chronological Notes

- **Moses 1446 BCE**
 - 2 Kings 6:1 - And it came to pass in the **four hundred and eightieth year** after the children of Israel had come out of the land of Egypt, in the fourth year of Solomon’s reign over Israel, in the month of Ziv, which *is* the second month, that he began to build the house of the LORD.
 - Exodus 12:41 - And it came to pass at the end of the **four hundred and thirty years—on that very same day**—it came to pass that all the armies of the LORD went out from the land of Egypt.
 - Judges 11:26 - While Israel dwelt in Heshbon and its villages, in Aroer and its villages, and in all the cities along the banks of the Arnon, for **three hundred years**, why did you not recover *them* within that time?
 - Galatians 3:17 - the law, which was **four hundred and thirty** years later [than the Promise]
- Key Dates
 - 931 – Kingdom divides
 - Israel (Samaria) to the north
 - Judah (Jerusalem) to the south
 - 841 – Jehu’s purge
 - 721 – Samaria’s siege
 - Started by Shalmaneser
 - Finished by Sargon
 - 701 – Sennacherib besieges Jerusalem
 - 609 – Josiah dies at Megiddo fighting Egypt
 - 605 – Nebuchadnezzar takes Daniel et al.
 - 597 – Nebuchadnezzar takes Ezekiel et al.
 - 586 – Nebuchadnezzar destroys the temple
