

Certification in Deeper Walk Prayer Ministry

Program Overview

The Deeper Walk School of Ministry provides an intensive, hands-on, heart-focused discipleship training program in practical ministry skills. You will gain the ministry tools needed to help hurting people experience freedom, understand their identity in Christ, walk in the Spirit and live in heart-focused (hesed) community.

Those who successfully complete this program will have the basic skills necessary to conduct emotional healing prayer sessions, recognize and deal with demonic interference, walk people through the *Steps to Freedom in Christ*, and help others begin growing in maturity skills. You will be certified as a Prayer Minister by Deeper Walk International, the leader in heart-focused discipleship training for the church today.

About the Program/Course Schedule

Cohort meetings are primarily focused on interactive laboratories for students to learn skills through experience-based practice. In order to help students gain the skills needed for ministering to people, these labs may not always address the same issues in the same weeks as the video lectures. Students should also expect significant work outside of the class, and may desire/need to meet with other students for practice and to complete assignments.

- 4. Experience being a client. Students will need to find a counselor, coach, spiritual director or prayer minister and attend six sessions with them in order to successfully complete the program.

Course 4: Practicum with Overview of Advanced Issues

Course 4 Objectives

- 1. Begin working with people outside the class environment (internship/practicum).
- 2. Implement a system of client care.
- 3. Successfully navigate different types of client sessions (see Observation list) as determined by qualified supervisors.
- 4. Recognize and appropriately determine how to handle advanced issues (including referring or consulting).
- 5. Begin developing a network of care providers for consultation, referral, etc.
- 6. Demonstrate sufficient competency in care provision to the satisfaction of appropriate assessors to begin delivering lay ministry services to be certified.

Additional Information

Course Work: Between class meetings, you will watch video lectures, read course materials, and complete assignments. Assignments will include both written work and practical ministry activities.

Commitment: This is a robust, intensive training that will require approximately 5-8 hours of coursework per week, both in and outside of the weekly group gatherings.

Certification: Official certification in Deeper Walk Prayer Ministry will be granted to trainees based on:

- Attendance 80% or more of classes
- Active Participation in meetings and ministry exercises
- Assignments earn a passing grade in each of the 4 Courses
- Assessment instructors will assess each trainee's readiness for effective prayer ministry

Disclaimer: Acceptance into the Certification program is not a guarantee of certification. Certification is a rigorous process which requires successful completion of the entire program, including demonstration of satisfactory performance of skills taught in the program. Successful completion of the program is ultimately determined by the instructional team.

Certification in Deeper Walk prayer Ministry is about caring for others and NOT a self-help/personal growth program. It is expected that participants have already experienced significant healing, recovery and personal growth and have developed the relational capacity to help others through similar experiences. Therefore, participants in the program are expected to display Parent or Elder level maturity (as defined by the Life Model) most of the time, and to have the emotional and relational capacity to

care for others even when under duress. This includes appropriate and balanced self-care (including ongoing personal growth) and self-sacrifice.

Our desire is to see everyone accepted into the program equipped to minister effectively as Deeper Walk Certified Prayer Ministers. As such, participants who demonstrate difficulties that the instructional team deem problematic for caring for others may be asked/required to seek appropriate intervention. If they are unable or unwilling to do so, they may be asked to leave the program. Certification in Deeper Walk Prayer Ministry is the basic, foundational training for Deeper Walk people-helpers. More advanced or specific training may be needed for some issues. Ongoing certification may require renewal and updated training.
